A renowned restaurant, the perfect place to recharge with a traditional meal before the return trip.

Kwanza Norte

Kwanza Norte Botanical Garden is a peaceful retreat with trails and scenic rest areas, ideal for reconnecting with nature.

Viewpoint

A 2.5h journey takes you to the Calandula Falls Viewpoint. Enjoy a short trail (10 minutes) with breathtaking views.

Lucala River

A magical ride near the falls, with fresh breezes and stunning scenery that create an unforgettable atmosphere.

Black Rocks

Striking rock formations that blend natural beauty with mystery, inviting reflection on Angola's geological heritage.
